- Wire a single pole, three-way and four-way switch in residential and commercial applications.
- Answer questions using the National Electrical Code pertaining to residential, commercial or industrial applications.
- Install basic wiring and grounding systems for residential, commercial or industrial applications.
- Install the following: push button, selector switch, limit switch, float switch, flow switch, contact block, control relay, contactor, timing relays, motor starters, and overload relays.
- Work with basic types of AC and DC motors and transformers.
