	Care of your iPad	
a.	How to Clean the Touch Screen	Wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth to remove oil left by your handsDon't use window cleaners, household cleaners, aerosol sprays, solvents, alcohol, ammonia, or abrasives to clean iPadAvoid getting moisture in openings. Avoid extreme cold or hot temperatures.
b.	Charging the Battery	(internal rechargeable battery) The battery icon in the upper-right corner of the status bar shows the battery level or charging status.  To charge iPad, connect it to a power outlet using the included <b>Dock Connector</b> to <b>USB Cable</b> and <b>10W USB Power Adapter</b> .

Basic Tasks		
1. Diagram of Controls & Features	(see back of handout)	
2. Turn iPad on	Press and hold the <b>Sleep/Wake</b> button until the Apple logo appears.	
3. Put iPad in <b>Sleep Mode</b>	Press the <b>On/Off button</b> and let go quickly	
4. Open an App	Tap its icon on the Home screen.	
5. Return to the Home Screen	Press the <b>Home</b> button	
6. View most recently used apps	Access all running apps by <b>double-clicking</b> the <b>Home</b> button.	
7. Remove or Close an App from the	Touch and hold the app icon until it begins to <b>jiggle</b> , then <b>tap</b> 👝	
recents List		
8. iPad's Pre-loaded Apps	(see handout on iPad Moodle)	
9. Moving and Re-Arranging App Icons	1 Touch and hold any icon until the icons jiggle.	
	2 Arrange the icons by dragging them.	
	3 Press the Home button to save your arrangement.	
10. Organizing with <b>Folders</b>		
To Create a Folder:	<b>Touch and hold an app icon</b> until they all start to <b>jiggle</b> , then drag the app	
	icon over another icon and release.	
To Re-name a Folder:	Tap to open the folder, then tap the name at the top and use the keyboard	
	to enter a new name. Press the <b>Home button to save your changes</b> .	
11. Hand Gestures	Tap, Tap Hold & Drag, Flick and Swipe, Pinch	
12. Volume Buttons	Volume button and Side Switch	
13. View in Portrait or Landscape		
14. Settings	Tap the Settings app to make set your preferences.	
15. Lock the <b>Screen Orientation</b>	Settings > General > Lock Orientation OR Mute (use the 'Side Switch' to lock)	
16. Accessibility Options	Settings > General > <b>Accessibility</b>	
17. Speak Selection	Settings > General > <b>Accessibility &gt; Speak Selection &gt; On</b> (notes app)	
	Have text read to you:	
	Select the text by touching and holding a word	
	Drag the selector to include all the text you want read	
	• Then tap Speak	
18. Using the Keyboard	(notes app)	
19. Screenshot	Press Home and the sleep/wake button simultaneously. Saved in photos	
20. Taking a Photo	(photo will remain on the iPad)	
21 Turn iPad off	Press and <b>hold the Sleep/Wake button</b> for a few seconds until the <b>red slider</b>	
	appears, then drag the slider.
