

## Kalamazoo Valley Community College

### Full-Time, First-Time, Degree Seeking Students Enrolling For The First Time For Fall 2013 Who Graduated or Transferred By Fall 2016

The following table presents information required by the federal government describing graduation rates of KVCC students. This table includes students who receive a degree within 150% of the time it “normally” takes to complete, which is typically three years. Unfortunately, the federal government modeled this table after four-year universities where a student would start on a full-time basis, select a formal program of study at the point of admission, and graduate without transferring to another university. At community colleges, such as KVCC, approximately one-third of students enroll on a full-time basis, many have not decided on a formal program of study at the point of admission, and many successfully transfer to four-year universities prior to meeting the degree requirements of KVCC programs. It is important to keep in mind that while it is difficult to describe the “typical” KVCC student, clearly those students included in this table are only a portion of a much more diverse group.
