**ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST** 

- □ Admission Complete an application online. You should begin this process by the first of April for fall semester classes or October for winter semester classes. You will receive your acceptance letter in the mail within one week. Applicants under the age of 14 will need to seek approval for admission from the Director of Admissions, Registration and Records. Please call 269.488.4281 for underage applicant procedures.
- □ **High School Approval –** Consult with your high school representative to determine your Early College or Dual Enrollment qualifications under the Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act (PSEO).
- Orientation To learn more about the Kalamazoo Valley campus and services, orientation is highly encouraged. Contact the Student Development Services to sign up for an orientation. If you are participating in an Early/Middle College program and have participated in an orientation through a high school, you do not need to attend a new student orientation. However, you should meet with a Kalamazoo Valley advisor or counselor to plan your college pathway to success. Log into MyValley and in My Links select "New Student On Campus Orientation" to schedule your appointment. While you are in MyValley, please click on "Enrollment Checklist" to review the Guided Self-Placement English and Math recommendations before discussing them with an advisor or counselor.
- Registration Register for classes online in MyValley or by coming on campus during posted registration hours. Registration begins in March for summer, in April for fall and October for winter, and continues through the start of classes.
- Payment Tuition bills are available online in MyValley. If you are paying for your own classes you may do so online, on campus or by mail during deferred payment periods.
  If you are affiliated with a public-school program for the Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Act, a completed PSEO Tuition Authorization form must be submitted to the Financial Services office prior to the payment deadline. The PSEO form must show the classes you are approved and registered for to retain your classes. The form is available online or from your high school.
- □ Student ID You must be registered for classes and present a photo ID to obtain your Valley ID. Visit the Texas Township Campus Services Desk, Culinary Allied Health Building or Anna Whitten Hall to pick it up in person. Alternatively, request it via the MyValley portal to receive it by mail. The card is needed for services and required at Arcadia Commons Campus for parking validation and door access.
