Application Deadline is April 1, 2015.

### **Statement of Scholarship Provisions**

The Kellogg Community Federal Credit Union College Scholarship will provide \$1,000 towards tuition at an accredited community college or university within Michigan. The scholarship will be payable to the college of your choice as a one-time payment for Fall 2015 tuition, not to include books. Five Scholarships will be awarded for 2015.

### **Statement of Recipient Requirements**

The Kellogg Community Federal Credit Union Scholarship requires that the recipient:

- Attend an accredited community college or university within Michigan or be working towards a certification or degree program in the trades at state supported community colleges
- Scholarships are available to traditional and non-traditional students
- Be enrolled as a full-time student (12+ credit hours) for the Fall 2015 semester
- Send KCFCU proof of full time status after enrollment
- Be a member of Kellogg Community Federal Credit Union and their account must be in good standing
- Every qualified candidate will be considered: however, financial need will be a factor, as well as, the individual's demonstration of good character, citizenship, and leadership.

Scholarship applications should be mailed to the following address and should be post marked no later than April 1, 2015. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
