## KALAMAZOO VALLEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE Pfizer Nursing Scholarship/Internship Eligibility Requirements

## **Eligibility Requirements for the Scholarship/Internship:**

- 1. Recipients of the scholarship will be required to meet the following:
  - Must be classified as an In-District Student for KVCC.
  - *Currently* enrolled full-time in the second semester of the KVCC nursing program and be eligible for NCLEX PN Exam during Summer 2011.
  - Agree to work at a designated health care facility; 32 hours a week for 15 weeks during the months of May, June, July, and August of 2011.
- 2. Scholarship application materials must be thoroughly completed utilizing the form that is available in the Financial Aid Office or on their website at <a href="www.kvcc.edu/financial">www.kvcc.edu/financial</a>, go to Scholarships, then Pfizer Nursing Scholarship/Internship. The essay portion may be submitted on a separate sheet of paper but must be attached to the application form.
- 3. Applicants must submit completed application materials to the Financial Aid Office.
- 4. The Scholarship will be administered in a two (2) step process:
  - a. The student will be required to complete a paid internship (32 hours/week) over a preset 15 week period at Family Health Center.
  - b. The remaining scholarship money will help cover the costs of the remaining 2 semesters of the Nursing Program as follows: (50% applied to each of the remaining semester costs)
    - -The student must enroll in the third  $(3^{rd})$  semester of the Nursing Program as a full-time student during Fall 2011.
    - -The student must enroll in the fourth  $(4^{th})$  semester of the Nursing Program as a full-time student during Winter 2012.
- 5. All applications must be received in the Financial Aid Office by March 30, 2011.
- 6. Scholarships are awarded to recipient on a one-time basis.

Notice: Pfizer will be notified who the recipient is for the scholarship award, their experience at Family Health Center and of their completion of the KVCC nursing program.
