Scholarship Criteria

- Student must be from West Michigan attending a Community College, 4 Year College or University or Trade School within Michigan
- Student must be from one of the following Michigan Counties (Allegan, Barry, Calhoun, Ionia, Isobella, Kalamazoo, Kent, Mecosta, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo, Oceana, Ottawa, and Van Buren Counties)
- Applicants must be currently enrolled at a Community College, 4 Year College or University or Trade School within Michigan
- Previously chosen applicants are not eligible

Scholarship Judging

- Scholarship award will be based on application judging.
- Applications will be judged on community service, leadership/extracurricular activities, short essays, and essay.
- Each application will be scored by at least two judges and an average score determined.
- Financial need will not be a factor in the applications process.
- A minimum student GPA of 2.0 is required.

Application Time Line 2017

- Applications will be available in March 1, 2017
- Applications must be post marked by May 15, 2017
- Applications will be scored by June 15, 2017
- Chosen applicant will be notified by end of June 2017
- Scholarship will be sent to the School for distribution to the student
- Chosen applicant has until July 15, 2017 to accept the Eric Verhaar Memorial Scholarship
