WHAT IS MCTI?

Since 1944, the Michigan Career and Technical Institute (MCTI) has provided training for adults with disabilities in Michigan. Today, MCTI is the second largest comprehensive rehabilitation training center in the United States, offering a unique blend of caring human support services and state-of-the-art training.




The school is administered by Michigan Rehabilitation Services, a bureau of the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, and accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) and the Council on Occupational Education (COE) located at 7840 Rosewell Road, Building 300 Suite 325 Atlanta, GA 30350.

WHO ATTENDS MCTI?

Students who are 18 years of age or older can attend MCTI. They may be referred by Michigan Rehabilitation Services, Veterans Affairs, Bureau of Services for Blind Persons, private rehabilitation agencies, or as a private pay individual.
