



#### **Dictionary of College Terms**

As you begin college there may be some words or terms that are unfamiliar to you. This "dictionary" will help you understand the college language.

ACCREDITATION The process whereby a nationally recognized agency or organization grants recognition to a college or program within the college indicating that it meets established standards of quality. Kalamazoo Valley Community College is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, as well as several other program accrediting agencies.

**ADD/DROP** The procedure through which students make a change in their schedule of classes. Add/Drop dates can be found online at www.kvcc.edu/admissions/registration. A full refund is awarded when officially dropping out of a class before the published refund deadline.

**ADMISSION** The process through which an applicant is accepted as a student at Kalamazoo Valley and authorized to register for classes.

**AUDIT** Enrollment in a class for information or personal enjoyment without the award of credit. Regular attendance is expected and tuition rates are the same as for credit courses.

**CERTIFICATE** An award granted for the successful completion of a college level program, usually requires completion of 30 credit hours and one academic year.

**CLASS SCHEDULE** A booklet containing information on the courses and sections to be offered in a given semester, including names of instructors, days, hours, room numbers, and course credit hours.

**CONTACT HOUR** The number of hours a student is expected to either be in a class or in another "instructional" setting (such as a lab or clinical setting) in a typical week for a course.

**COURSE NUMBER** A number assigned to identify a course. Kalamazoo Valley uses a three digit number and an abbreviation for the subject area. Example, the course number for College Writing I is ENG 110.

**COURSE REFERENCE NUMBER** A five-digit number the college assigns to each scheduled time a course is offered. The same course may be offered many times during a semester; using the reference number during registration will enroll the student in the course time of his/her choice.

**CREDIT HOUR** The unit by which the college measures course work. A credit hour is basically the same as a clock hour meaning a three credit hour course would meet three hours a week.

**DEGREE** Title given for the completion of an academic program. The minimum number of credit hours for the associate degree is 62 and is generally completed in two academic years.

**ELECTIVE** A course in the program of study for which the student has some options, as opposed to a required course.

**FEE** A charge for special items, services, or course materials not covered by tuition. www.kvcc.edu

**FINANCIAL AID** Any source of funds available to assist students and their families with the costs of attending college. Financial aid consists of grants, scholarships, employment and loans.

**GENERAL EDUCATION** Courses required in all college programs including areas of communication both written and verbal, social science, and mathematics/science.

**GRADE POINT AVERAGE** The grade point average (GPA) is determined by dividing the total number of quality points earned by the number of semester hours attempted.

**LEARNING ASSESSMENT** A procedure in which a student may receive credit for a course through a variety of methods, including certificate/licensure recognition, portfolio completion and/or exam.

**QUALITY POINTS** The number of quality points earned in a course is determined by multiplying the grade point value by the number of credits for the particular course.

**REGISTRATION** The process of enrolling in a course or courses each semester. Students must be registered and paid in order to participate in classes and receive credit toward their degree.

**RESIDENCY STATUS** The tuition rate classification of a student determined by the school district in which the student resides. Please refer to www.kvcc.edu/admissions/ registration/verificationres.htm for more information.

**SEMESTER** The three academic periods during which courses are conducted each year. Fall is September thru December, Winter is January thru May, and Summer is May thru August.

**TRANSCRIPT** A copy of the student's permanent academic record. It becomes official when the seal of the college and authorized signature become a part of the copy. Official transcripts must be obtained from the Records Office, Room 9140, Tel. 488.4281.

**TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION** The procedure for awarding transfer credit for equivalent courses completed at another college, university or in the military service. A transcript evaluation must be completed in order for previous credits to apply toward a degree.

**TUITION** The amount of money charged for each course in which the student enrolls, based on total number of contact hours. The current tuition rate is always listed in the front pages of the class schedule.

**WITHDRAWAL** The procedure followed by students wishing to be removed from a class. The official request must be submitted prior to the published deadline. A "W," which does not affect the student's Kalamazoo Valley grade point average, will be recorded on the student's transcript.

**WORK STUDY** A financial aid program which provides jobs for students either on or off-campus. A student must demonstrate financial need by completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student-Aid-) at www.fafsa.gov. Veterans receiving certain GI benefits may also be eligible for VA work study. Contact Veteran Services Office for information.


